

Admission Requirements:

Admission Test:

Admission test will have two parts in 100 marks;

Part 1: Contains multiple-choice questions covering English language & literature and general knowledge.

Part 2: Contains written English on essay, paragraph, terms of literature, literary age and prominent authors.
